Regulation: In case of force majeure the organizer reserves the right to shorten the

race by the part which cannot be realized. In all instances, the decision is up to the main referee and the director of the race. The last lap bell is the deciding factor in awarding lap gains or losses for an individual or a group of riders. After the bell is rung, no lap can be gained or lost.

In case of a crash or accident, it will be proceeded according to the Track races rules of Czech Cycling Association (§10, page 31, articles D

1017 - D 1020).

Gears: As stated in valid rules of Czech Cycling Federation.

Technical regulation for 500 + 1 kolo race

Stages I – IV consist of 100 laps each, the final stage (V) has 100 + 1 laps.

Points are awarded in every 5th lap -5, 3, 2, 1 points. Every 50th and 100th laps are awarded with double points. In stages I - IV, lap gained has bigger value than points gained. All riders who score a lap or points in given stage will get omnium points (see the Omnium points table). Furthermore, If more than 20 riders score a lap or points in a given stage, each of them will get additional 1 omnium point. Total of omnium points after the stage IV will set the rankings before the final stage.

In the final fifth stage, the points will be added omnium points achieved in stages I-IV. 50th, 100th and 101st lap is awarded with double points. Lap gained is awarded with 20 points, lap lost with -20 points. The overall winner is the rider with highest score of total points: omnium points from stages I-IV and actual points from stage V.

As of the stage II, the leading rider will wear the yellow jersey for the whole stage. Before the stage, the yellow jersey will be presented to the actual leader by the director of the race or by the main sponsor of the race.

Thus, wearing a yellow jersey is prohibited for other riders.

Technical regulation for 300 + 1 kolo race

Points are awarded in every 5th lap -5, 3, 2, 1 points. The last awarding of points in each stage yields double points. In the final fifth stage, the last (+1) lap yields double points too. In stages I - IV, lap gained has bigger value than points gained. All riders who score a lap or points in given stage will get omnium points (see the Omnium points table). Furthermore, If more than 20 riders score a lap or points in a given stage, each of them will get additional 1

omnium point. Total of omnium points after the stage IV will set the rankings before the final stage.

In the final fifth stage, the points will be added omnium points achieved in stages I-IV. Lap gained is awarded with 20 points, lap lost with -20 points. The overall winner is the rider with highest score of total points: omnium points from stages I-IV and actual points from stage V.

Common technical regulation

for 220 + 1 kolo, 130 + 1 kolo and 100 + 1 kolo races

Points are awarded in every 5th lap -5, 3, 2, 1 points. The last awarding of points in each stage yields double points. In the final fifth stage, the last (+1) lap yields double points too. Lap gained has bigger value than points gained.

All riders who score a lap or points in given stage will get omnium points (see the Omnium points table). The overall winner is the rider with highest score of omnium points. In case of equality of omnium points after the last stage, the outcome will be settled based on the rankings of the last stage.


